READ:

Read Isaiah 43:1-7 out loud twice. For the first time through, read it normally. Take a few minutes to discuss any first impressions you have on the text. For the second read-through, emphasize each “I” and each “you” as you read aloud.

Discuss:

Did the emphasis of the 2 words give you a new or different understanding of the text? What are your impressions on what this text has to say about the lengths that God will go for those he created?

Finish this sentence (feel free to share with others, or write them down):

If God would use Egypt as a ransom for me, I can certainly trust Him to help me with_____

Activity:

If there are small children in your home, have them go on a “scavenger hunt” and pick 10 things they see in their house that they think God, and their family, would gladly give up for them to be happy and safe.

Creator God, You have shown me time and again that your love for me is beyond all measure. In this new year, help me to remember that I am created by You and I am worthy of Your love. Help me to be the person that demonstrates Your love to others, so that they might also see their worth to You. Amen.
