Theme: Pray – Work - Wait

Scripture for the Week: Acts 27:39- 28:10 (NIV) These scriptures can be found at Biblegateway.com. Have one person read the scripture out loud.

Discussion:

1. Is it difficult for you to ask God to help you or does it come natural? How about asking others?
2. How do you feel when you are asked to work toward a goal of some sort - do you think that someone else should do the work too, or just you? Do you find work a joy or a bother?
3. Do you find it difficult to wait to receive things or answers to prayer?
5. If you knew God wanted to bless you, would you be willing to pray, work and wait for the answer?

Activity for the Week:

Plan a party for next weekend or soon thereafter. Give everyone in the family a responsibility. The youngest children can draw name-tags and place mats. The middle age children can plan the activities and games for the family to play at the party. The adults can plan the food. On the day of the party, have each one in the family participate in putting the party together. When the party is over or the next day, ask each family member how they felt about doing their part in making the party happen. How did they feel waiting for the day of the party?

Prayer:

Lord, thank you for helping us with our lives. Help us to trust you to guide us in making the decisions that affect us and others. Help us to be willing to work toward those goals that would make us successful in our lives and in the lives of other people. Thank you for caring about us so much that you sent your Holy Spirit to guide us and give us wisdom.
