Week: March 28

Theme: Jesus’ Triumphant Entry

Scriptures: Luke 19:28-40; Philippians 2:5-11

Think about how Jesus doesn’t come as we expect. What have you expected from Jesus? How has he been in your life in unexpected ways...at just the right time?

READ: Luke 19:28-40

Question 1: What event is recorded in this passage? What is its relation to Easter?

Question 2: In your opinion, why do you think the Lord Jesus needed a colt that had never been ridden before? What would a “king” typically arrive on?

Question 3: If you were the owner of the colt, would you be willing to give it up to Jesus? What do you suppose compelled these people to give up their colt?

Question 4: Would you have praised Jesus like the crowd did? Why were they so excited? What could you praise Jesus for today?

Question 5: What do you think it means when Jesus says, “...if they keep quiet, the stones will cry out.” How does God’s creation praise him?

PRAYER: Jesus, we love you and admit that we don’t praise you enough—we let the mountains cry out, instead of us. Help us to see your entry into our lives every day, and make you king of our lives.
